*Eric and Joe peek out on stage.*

ERIC: Coast is clear! Let's go!

*Eric runs to center stage and sets a footstool down. Joe follows him.*

ERIC: Okay, man, let 'er rip.

*Joe steps up to the footstool, then backs away.*

JOE: Can't do it, man.

ERIC: What?

JOE: I can't do it!

ERIC: Why not?

JOE: I don't trust it, man!

ERIC: We're not going to get in trouble, man.

JOE: I'm not worried about getting in trouble!

ERIC: Then what are you worried about?

JOE: That.

*Joe points at the footstool.*

ERIC: You're kidding.

JOE: Nope.

ERIC: You don't trust the footstool?

JOE: Not at all, no.

ERIC: It's your footstool.

JOE: I know, but I'm sorry, I don't trust it.

ERIC: What are you afraid of?

JOE: I don't know, man, it just doesn't look right.

ERIC: It's the same footstool you've used a dozen times over.

*Eric pulls out a tape measure and measures the stool: length, height, width.*
