NARRATOR READS:

Parables of Redemption: In the Bible, Jesus often spoke in parables to illustrate His message.

And it was so important to Him that we understand the meaning of redemption
that He gave us three parables on the topic:

In His Parable of the Lost Sheep, we read about the shepherd
who had a flock of a hundred sheep.

When he discovers that one of them had wandered off,
he leaves the other ninety-nine in the safety of the pasture
to go and rescue the one that had gone astray.

When the shepherd finds the lost sheep,
he puts it on his shoulders and carries it safely back to his flock.
He then shares the good news with his friends, and they rejoiced together.

In the Parable of the Lost Coin, we see a woman who had ten silver coins,
but had lost one. She lights a lamp; she sweeps the floors,
and vigorously searches her entire house until she finds it.
When she does, she tells her friends and neighbors and they celebrated with her.

And in Jesus' Parable of the Lost Son, we read of a young man
who goes to his father seeking his inheritance.

After receiving it, the son leaves for a distant land,
and squanders everything he has in a wild and sinful life.
Broken, desperate, ashamed, and hungry the son returns home
to see if his father will take pity on him and hire him as a servant.

Not only does his father take him back, he welcomes his son with open arms
and celebrates his return.

He prepares him a feast; he clothes him in his finest robe
and provides fresh sandals for his feet.
And in a generous act of love, he places a highly treasured ring
on his son's finger. All was forgiven and the prodigal son was fully restored.

In the parables we see that what had been lost was of great value.

Following that loss, a desperate and intensive search begins.

And when what had been lost is found, a great celebration takes place.

With each story, Jesus illustrated how important the lost are to God.

He sees those who are lost as valuable and in need of redemption.
And when we are found—when we return to Him,
Jesus tells us that a great celebration takes place in Heaven!
